TIPS FOR PARENTS

- Please arrive 10 minutes early on the first day of classes.
- Ensure your child arrives and is picked up on time each day.
- You must sign your child in and out each day with their instructor before and after classes.
- If your child has your permission to go home on their own you must initial the consent form.
- Advise our staff of any health concerns including food allergies or special needs.
- Parents/guardians are responsible for administering any medications required by their child. Although our staff members have First Aid training, they cannot administer medication.
- Please take your child's artwork home at the end of the week.
- Staff and volunteers answer questions, supervise snack and lunch breaks. Please inform your child that they are available for help.
- Ensure your child is sent to camps and programs wearing old, comfortable clothing that can get dirty.
- Long hair should be tied back.
- Please LABEL jackets, bags or other belongings with your child's name.
- For full-day camp, provide your child with two snacks and lunch. For half-day camps provide your child with one snack. Please do not send money to purchase lunch.
- **NUT AWARENESS - Due to sensitivities please do not pack anything with PEANUTS OR TREE NUTS.**
- Send along a water bottle and sunscreen labelled with your child's name.
- Please DO NOT send valuables with your child as we are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

BEHAVIOUR POLICY

It is our goal for children attending The ACT Arts Centre/Maple Ridge Pitt Meadows Arts Council programs to have the best experience possible in a fun and welcoming environment. We expect that every child will follow instructions from staff and leaders, include others in all activities, show respect and help each other.

If any child has difficulty in behaviour expectations we will:

- Give an initial warning to help the child understand the impact their behaviour has on others.
- If the behaviour continues, they will be removed from the class for a break. The child's parent/guardian will be notified of their child's difficulty in behaviour and asked to speak with their child about expectations.
- If behaviour still continues, the parent/guardian will be contacted and asked to pick up their child immediately with the child missing the rest of the day's activity.
- A child may be asked to leave the program if his/her behaviour impacts safe and effective participation in our programs. This request will take effect only after consultation between the parents, program staff and the Arts Program Coordinator.
